He goes on: "Many people are looking for an ear that will listen to them. They do not find it among Christians, because these Christians are talking where they should be listening."

He says, "There is a a kind of listening with half an ear that presumes already to know what the other person has to say. It is an impatient, inattentive listening, that despises the brother and is only waiting for a chance to speak and so get rid of the other person." (pp.75-76)
